



NPMS Overview

- The NPMS is a GIS dataset containing locations and attributes of gas transmission and hazardous liquid pipelines, as well as LNG plants and breakout tanks
 - Distribution and gathering lines are not included
- Hazardous liquid and gas transmission pipeline operators must submit their data to the NPMS each year or notify PHMSA of no changes
- GIS data is displayed through web (Public Viewer, PIMMA) and mobile interfaces







NPMS Applications

- The Public Viewer is open to all and allows the user to see pipeline data and attributes for a single county per session (YouTube tutorial)
- PIMMA requires a username and password and is available to government employees and pipeline operators
 - Extent is limited to the user's jurisdiction

- Automatically <u>reset your PIMMA password!</u>

Who qualifies for PIMMA access?

- All Federal, state, and local government employees, once verified, may access PIMMA data for their jurisdiction
- You may share the data with a contractor and your working partners but are advised not to share your PIMMA password
- Neighboring counties are granted if the requestor can provide justification
