


2018 Program Improvements

- The State agencies responsible for damage prevention enforcement were included in the ESG – Pipeline Edition
- The DD24 video was edited, renamed Excavation Emergencies and made freely available for download from the website
- The PO Newsletter highlighted information about PIMMA and a webinar was conducted by PHMSA on September 18, 2018
- An online Information Request form that automatically sends requests to all members in a selected County was added to the web site
- A hard copy of the *Information Request* form along with a postage paid return envelope were included in the packets mailed to Public Officials




2018 Program Improvements

- Information about the Fire Department Pipeline Response Emergency Planning and Preparedness Toolkit (FD PREPP) added to the resource section of the PERG
- The ER training scenarios were redeveloped in HTML5
- A narrated PowerPoint presentation following the content in the PERG booklet was created and made available
- An Access database was created that generates county transmission mileage reports using the county mileage data available from the NPMS website
- The School website was reconstructed in Umbraco
- The POAS group launched several new initiatives
- The Drain Tile Safety Coalition was formed to improve safety and prevent drain tile accidents



- \$1.10 per excavator




Excavator Coverage Map - 2018





- Four page cover letter customized by County
- Pipeline Emergency Response Guidelines & Training CD
- Pipeline Awareness Newsletter
- ISEPA Mapping Application
- ER Capabilities Application
- Information Request Form
- Packet mailed in September
- 1052 Counties in 35 states
- 27,000 Agencies in 2018
- Base dues are \$275 per County







Identified Site Emergency Planning App.

- Web based mapping application
- All types of pipelines can be included
- Pipeline specific information is displayed
 - Company Name
 - Product Transported (types from Pipelines Nearby)
 - Pipeline Size (nominal outside diameter)
 - Evacuation Distance (varies by product)
 - Emergency and non-emergency phone numbers
 - Link to member emergency response document
- KMZ file returned to members for verification
- Deadline for Member info is July 1





ISEPA Map Screen

Identified Site Registry

- Web based mapping application Identified Site Emergency Planning Application (ISEPA)
- Letter to agencies in November
- Unique login ID and password for agencies
- Buffer areas are the recommended initial evacuation distances based on member data
- System generated email to members with site data
- User history download available to members
- GIS data needed by September 1
- Member Dues are \$75 per County
- Revisions to the Marker Decals for HCA's?



Pipelines Nearby

- For Affected Public and Emergency Responders
- Web-based mobile friendly application
- Selection by entering address, coordinates or by placing a point on the map
- Information that is displayed:
 - Type of pipeline or product transported
 - Pipeline location distance and direction (no map)
 - Emergency and Non-Emergency phone numbers
 - Signs of a release, hazards and emergency response
- Cost is included in the annual membership dues
- Pipeline data can be provided anytime



School Pipeline Safety Program

- Partnership Danielle Dawn Smalley Foundation
- Three Options for School Communications:
 - Tier I \$160 / year / school
 School web site and annual mailing in the fall
 - Tier II \$260 / year / school
 Web meeting once every four years
 - Tier III \$460 / year / school
 Personal visit once every four years
 Cost reduced to \$360 within 150 miles of Dallas, TX
- 4 year commitment is required for Tier II or III
- Approximately 600 schools currently enrolled


811 Awareness – JJ Harrison

- Directed toward the general public rodeo events
- 811 logo is displayed -
 - Front and back of Jersey and western shirts
 - Rodeo Barrel and promotional items
 - Pickup truck and semi-trailer
 - Web page and social media sites
- Additional information is also provided at events
- 30 events, 13 States, 40,000 miles annually
- Sponsorships are flexible (no minimum amount and Association membership is not required)
- 2019 program budget is \$40,000

 - Baseline Survey and Four Year Effectiveness Evaluations




Ag Communications Program

 - One Calls and Other Organizations




Additional Initiatives

 - Distribution operator working group focused on public awareness / damage prevention practices


