




#### **2019 Program Improvements**

- The full text of Part 196 was included again in the Excavation Safety Guide – Pipeline Edition
- The state agencies responsible for enforcement were included with the updates for the State damage prevention laws
- Data from the commercial list sources (InfoUSA and Axiom) was used for all the states and the available data for active licensed contractors was used to supplement the mailing list
- The Public Officials Newsletter was expanded from twelve pages to sixteen pages
- A new feedback/information request form was included on the inside back cover of the newsletter along with instructions about how to submit information requests online




#### **2019 Program Improvements**

- The Newsletter highlighted information about development near pipelines and the PIMMA application provided by PHMSA.
- A one-hour webinar was conducted by Leigha Gooding with PHMSA on October 10 to explain how to get access to and use the PIMMA application
- Development of a series of videos incorporating the content of the Pipeline Emergency Response Guidelines booklet was initiated
- The ER training web site was restructured to accept the new video content and allow the scenarios to be downloaded
- Continued quarterly email communications with the County Emergency Managers and highlighted the October 10 PIMMA webinar along with other data available from the NPMS web site



- 48,000 Officials in 2019






#### PO Newsletter - 2020 Activities

  - Evacuation distances for Schools and other sites




- Four page cover letter customized by County

- Mailing sent in September
- 1055 Counties in 36 states
- 27,000 Agencies in 2019







# Identified Site Emergency Planning App.

- Web based mapping application
- All types of pipelines can be included
- Pipeline specific information is displayed
  - Company Name
  - Product Transported (types from Pipelines Nearby)
  - Pipeline Size (nominal outside diameter)
  - Evacuation Distance (varies by product)
  - Emergency and non-emergency phone numbers
  - Link to member emergency response document
- KMZ file returned to members for verification
- Deadline for Member info is July 1




#### **ISEPA Map Screen**








#### ER Program – 2020 Activities

- Pipeline Emergency Response Guidelines
  - Incorporate video content using Zappar
- > Training Web Site
  - Develop the complete set of training videos for the PERG content
- > Lower base dues to \$250 per county
- > Topics for email communications to CEMAs?
  - Develop County Pipeline Annex Template to capture how agencies & operators will engage in "mutual assistance"?
- Other improvements?




## **Identified Site Registry**

- Web based mapping application Identified Site Emergency Planning Application (ISEPA)
- Letter to agencies in November
- Unique login ID and password for agencies
- Buffer areas are the recommended initial evacuation distances based on member data
- System generated email to members with site data
- User history download available to members
- GIS data needed by September 1
- Member Dues are \$75 per County
- Revisions to the Marker Decals for HCA's?




# **Pipelines Nearby**

- For Affected Public and Emergency Responders
- Web-based mobile friendly application
- Selection by entering address, coordinates or by placing a point on the map
- Information that is displayed:
  - Type of pipeline or product transported
  - Pipeline location distance and direction (no map)
  - Emergency and Non-Emergency phone numbers
  - Signs of a release, hazards and emergency response
- Cost is included in the annual membership dues
- Pipeline data can be provided anytime




## School Pipeline Safety Program

- Partnership Danielle Dawn Smalley Foundation
- Three Options for School Communications:
  - Tier I \$150 / year / school
    School web site and annual mailing in the fall
  - Tier II \$250 / year / school
    Web meeting once every four years
  - Tier III \$450 / year / school
    Personal visit once every four years
    Cost reduced to \$350 within 150 miles of Dallas, TX
- 4 year commitment is required for Tier II or III
- Approximately 680 schools currently enrolled


#### 811 Awareness – JJ Harrison

- Directed toward the general public rodeo events
- 811 logo is displayed -
  - On Jersey and western shirts
  - Rodeo Barrel and promotional items
  - Pickup truck and semi-trailer
  - Web page and social media sites
- Additional information is also provided at events
- 30 events, 13 States, 40,000 miles annually
- Sponsorships are flexible (no minimum amount and Association membership is not required)
- 2020 program budget is \$35,000

  - Baseline Survey and Four Year Effectiveness Evaluations




## **Ag Communications Program**

  - One Calls and Other Organizations






