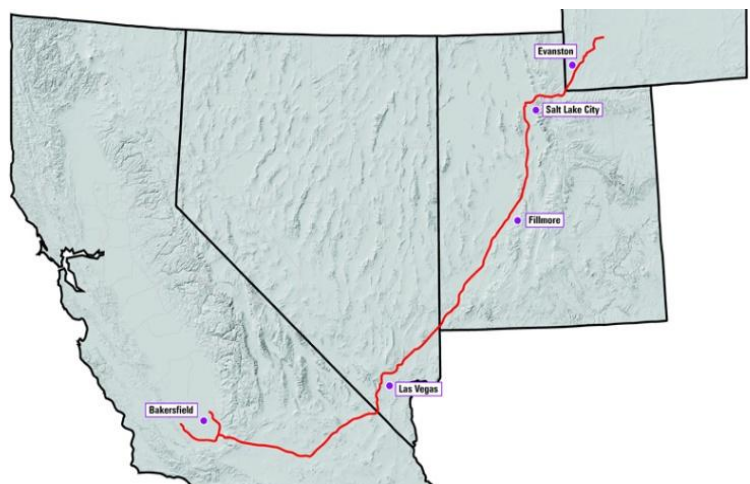
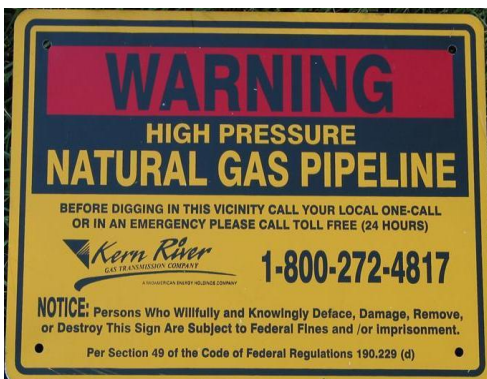
**COMMITMENT TO SAFETY, HEALTH, & ENVIRONMENT**

Kern River is committed to safety and believes it is an integral part of the company's performance. Kern River's policy is to meet or exceed all applicable local state and federal safety laws and regulations in the construction and operation of its pipelines and facilities.

Pipelines are the safest form of transportation, according to National Transportation Safety Board and Department of Transportation statistics. Without pipelines, energy products such as gasoline, diesel, natural gas and propane would have to be transported by truck, rail and waterways at a much greater risk to the public and the environment.

The safety of interstate pipelines is regulated by the DOT's Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration. The DOT imposes a broad range of rigorous standards and inspection requirements for pipeline design, material specifications, construction standards, and maintenance and testing requirements. Kern River offers a balanced approach to meeting the West's growing demand for clean-burning natural gas while supporting the protection and preservation of natural resources. Kern River is committed to protecting the environment and operating energy facilities in a safe and reliable manner.

Kern River understands and respects the risks associated with the energy industry. Pipelines are the most efficient and environmentally sensitive method of transporting energy. In all of its operations, Kern River does its best to minimize the impact to the environment and surrounding communities.
