ExxonMobil owns and operates a Department of Transportation (DOT) regulated liquid CO2 transportation pipeline in Wyoming. The CO2 is produced by our Shute Creek Facility in Lincoln County, then compressed at our Sweetwater compressor station. CO2 leaves the Shute Creek Meter Station through a 24-inch pipeline known as the Rock Springs Mainline, which continues along side Highway #372. At the Green River Junction, mile post 10, a 20-inch pipeline spurs off & heads east across Red Desert 113 miles to our Bairoil Meter Station known as the Bairoil Mainline. Customers along this line take CO2 for enhanced oil recovery. The 24" Rock Springs Mainline continues from the junction 12 miles to Rock Springs Metering Station, which is between Rock Springs & Green River North of I-80. Along the way, customers take small quantities of CO2 for purification. The CO2 then leaves the Rock Springs Station and heads to Colorado for enhanced oil recovery.


ExxonMobil trains our operations personnel according to the DOT Operator Qualification requirements. We also conduct periodic pipeline emergency response drills. In addition, only those contractors that have the applicable DOT Operator Qualifications are allowed to perform work on our pipeline.


COMMITMENT TO SAFETY, HEALTH & ENVIRONMENT
