Roaring Fork owns and operates the Chalk Bluff Gas Plant, a facility with Natural Gas Liquid (NGL) processing and CO2 removal capabilities. Residue gas is delivered to RFIGT at the Cheyenne Hub in Weld County, CO, and NGLs are delivered to Overland Pass Pipeline Company (OPPL) also at the Cheyenne Hub. Over 100 miles of low and high pressure gathering systems feed gas to the Plant from producing areas in Laramie County, WY, and Weld County, CO.

Roaring Fork Midstream also operates a crude oil gathering system including a truck unloading terminal centrally located. Deliveries are currently made to Tallgrass Energy's Pony Express Pipeline at the Carpenter lateral, with future connections to other major crude takeaway being developed in response to customer demand. Roaring Fork Interstate Gas Transmission, LLC (RFIGT) has been formed to own and operate an open-access, interstate gas transmission pipeline extending from north of Cheyenne, Wyoming, to an interconnection with Wyoming Interstate Company (WIC) at the Cheyenne Hub in Weld County, Colorado.
